

The property is 211.4 +/- acres and is fully fenced and crossed fenced, making it ready for your cattle or other livestock. With a great mix of upland pastures, wetlands, creeks and upland hardwoods, it has the makings for a sportsman's paradise. There is a large population of Osceola Turkeys on the ranch and in the surrounding area along with deer and hogs. There is a 6" well with a John Deere diesel power unit still on the property where the former citrus grove once was, making this land ready to farm if you so desire. Lake Buffum is one of Central Florida's premier fishing lakes. This property has a small sliver of land on the water on either side of the old boat ramp and is 1/4 down the road from the brand-new county boat ramp. This property has a rural and secluded feel while being less than a 10-minute drive from both US 27 and US 17, carrying you to many of the larger cities in the area.




